1. God’s Judgment Is According to Truth – Vs. 1-5- Vs. 2 – *“But we know the judgment of God is according to the truth against those who practice such things.”*

- “Surely God will not judge me!”
- “God is a loving God who does not judge!”
- “Man is basically good – he just makes bad choices – nobody’s perfect!”

2. God’s Judgment Is According to Deeds – Vs. 6-10 – Vs. 6 – *“(God) Who will render every man according to his deeds.”*
